

Construction Notice – Electrical Upgrade Work Fraser Highway, from 164 Street to 166 Street, Surrey

May 17, 2024

We're working closely with the Surrey Langley SkyTrain Project team to accommodate the rapid transit extension from Surrey to Langley. This work includes the installation of a duct bank to accommodate the relocation of power lines from the north side of Fraser Highway to the south side.

A duct bank is a series of plastic conduits encased in concrete that house and protect underground cables. Construction will result in some eastbound and westbound lane closures and will impact driveway access on Fraser Highway. Please see the map on page 2.

Where: Fraser Highway, starting west of 164 Street towards 166 Street in Surrey.

When: Anticipated to start May 27 with targeted completion by the end of June.

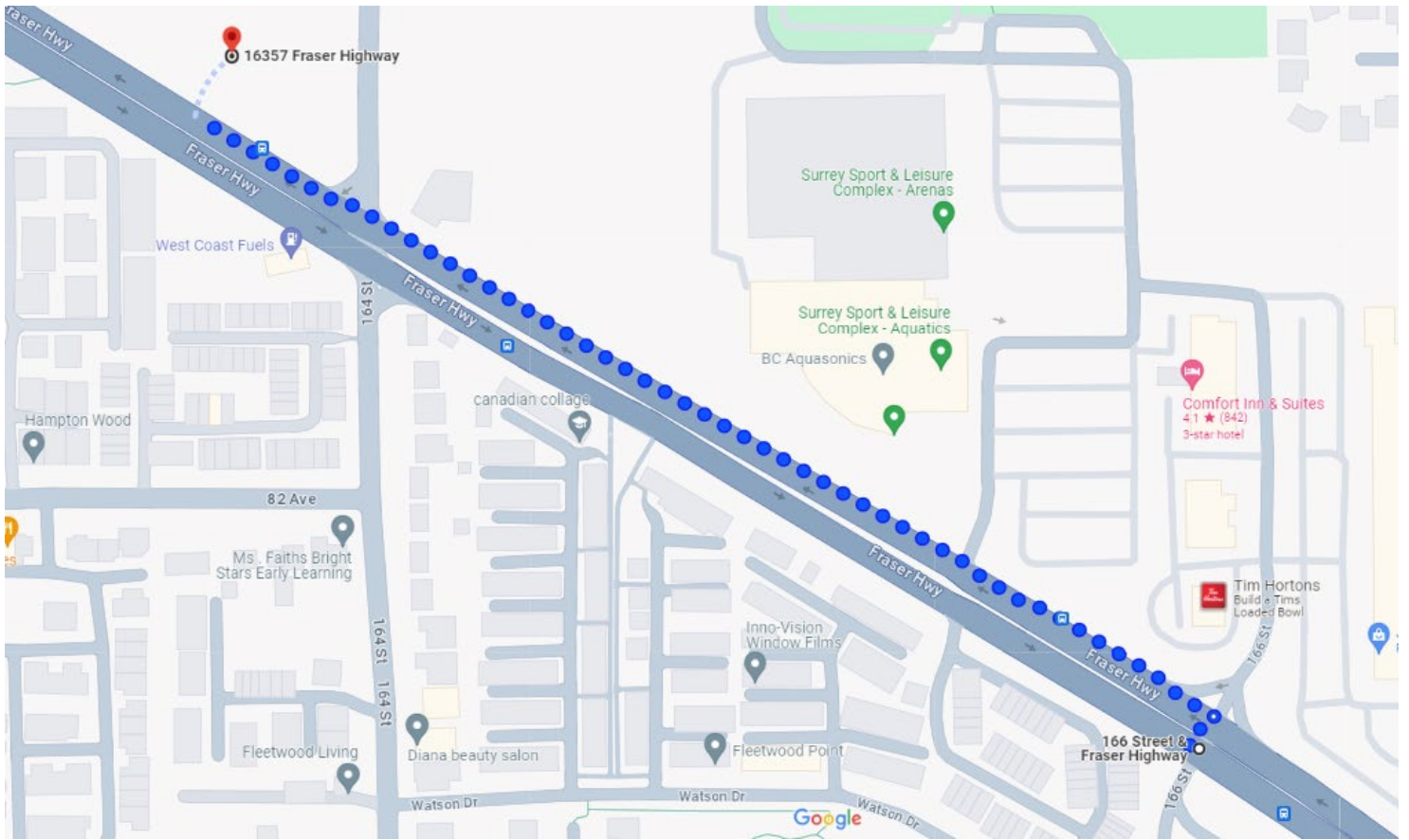
Working Hours: Monday to Friday from 7 a.m. to 5 p.m.

This work requires temporary traffic pattern changes. Traffic will be reduced to a single lane, in each direction. Please note that access to/from Fraser Highway may be restricted. Crews will provide alternative access where driveways may be impacted. Existing access to the sports complex and businesses from 166 Street will be maintained.

Safety is our top priority. Drivers are advised to plan ahead and expect delays. Please reduce speed in the construction zone and follow the directions of traffic control personnel and posted signage.
